There is no other service that day Many thanks to the stewards for their continued service. There is still no Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for the time being. It is becoming increasingly obvious that the lockdown, coupled with vaccinations, is reducing infection rates.

We are now seeing a great increase in requests for Baptism, and suggest that, if you want to arrange a baptism before the end of this year, you should contact us in the next month. Until we are able to return to a more normal pattern of worship, Fr Peter is available by appointment for any pastoral need. Weddings and baptisms are now allowed, but only with 6 people present. Funerals continue to be restricted to 30 people.
