

Over these many years, Volunteers have driven and accompanied patients to thousands of Health Centre and Hospital Appointments as well as providing a Friendship Service. Sadly the decision has been made to close down the Organisation. Please pray for the generous people in the past who have given so much of their time and love to help others. Perhaps God has another plan!

Thank you those of you who have continued to join us, in person or online. We hope that, with all vulnerable groups fully Vaccinated, more of you will feel confident enough to return to Mass. We are now seeing a great increase in requests for Baptism, and suggest that, if you want to arrange a baptism before the end of this year, you should contact us in the next month. Until we are able to return to a more normal pattern of worship, Fr Peter is available by appointment for any pastoral need. Weddings and baptisms are now allowed, with 30 people present. Funerals at St Mary's are now restricted to our Mass number of 50.

For Masses during the week we no longer need to have stewards before the Mass, but cleaners afterwards are still needed. At weekend Masses and Funerals, where 50 people are allowed, we still have to have two stewards and cleaners. It is looking increasingly unlikely that restrictions will be reduced next week. After the government announcement it will take a few days for the Diocese to tell us if and when any changes to our present rules are possible

We shall celebrate First Holy Communion with last year's and this year's groups at special Masses on Saturday mornings in late June and July, as numbers at Mass are likely still be restricted. Mothers' Prayers now takes place in church after Mass each Friday. Mass on Wednesday evenings (not this week) & 11.00am Sunday will be streamed

Please tell all your fellow parishioners how safe it feels in church and encourage everyone to be part of the real, not just virtual, community again. Fr Peter, Deacon Tony, Deacon Chris.
